

DRUGS IN BASKETBALL BY LAWS

1. Introduction

- 1.1 These By-laws are made under Article 10.2.2 of the Constitution of The Victorian Basketball Association Incorporated ("Basketball Victoria"), are known as "the Drugs in Basketball By-laws" and commence on 1 January 2001.
- 1.2 All By-laws previously made concerning drugs in basketball are rescinded.

2. Anti-Doping Policies

- 2.1 Basketball Victoria adopts the anti-doping policies of the Australian Basketball Federation as proclaimed from time to time by that Federation.

3. Recognition of Other Decisions

- 3.1 Basketball Victoria and affiliated association shall recognise and give effect to any finding and sanction made by:
 - The Australian Basketball federation for breach of its anti-doping policy; or
 - Any other sporting body of a breach of an anti-doping policy where that breach would be a breach of the Australian Basketball association's policy.

4. Breach Referred to Tribunal

- 4.1 Where an alleged breach of the anti-doping policy comes to the notice of Basketball Victoria any affiliated association or any of their officials or administrators, that breach shall be referred to a Tribunal established under the Tribunal By-laws.
- 4.2 Where an alleged breach is referred to a Tribunal under by-law 4.1, the Tribunal shall exercise all the powers and duties as though it was a matter under the Tribunal By-laws.
- 4.3 Penalties imposed by a Tribunal shall be those penalties under the Australian Basketball association's policy.
